A few years ago Bottle Breacher Founder and CEO, Eli "First and foremost, what drew me to Epilog was the Crane, was given a gift from his brother after his return home from deployment. In the past 18 months, Bottle Breacher has added more Epilog systems to their lineup. This comes in handy as they work with a variety of materials on any given day.



Engrave a Bamboo Vanity Set with a Laser

Bathroom decor can speak volumes about an individual's style, yet is often overlooked. Personalized bamboo vanity sets are the perfect asset to incorporate a sense of elegance and cohesiveness that will be sure to impress your quests.



- Bamboo Bathroom Vanity Set we purchased ours from Amazon.com
- An Epilog Laser System
- 1) Open the file and swap out the letter with your initial. Adjust the print settings and choose Center Engraving.



2) Place the the object in the laser and measure to find the center. Using the Red Dot pointer, locate the center and set as Home Position.

Settings on a 50-watt Helix:

SP 50 / PWR 100 / DPI 600



3) Press go and repeat the process with

Remove any smoke residue with a damp cloth and enjoy your beautifully personalized vanity set!





4) (Optional) Incorporate a colorfill in the process to add a unique look! This can is achieved by simply masking the face of the object prior to engraving and painting the engraved area with acrylic paint. Finishing with a polyurethane or lacquer will protect the colorfill while adding a nice sheen.
